Dr. Dessa Sadovnick completed her M.Sc. in Human Genetics from McGill University and subsequently received her PhD in Genetics from the University of British Columbia.. She is currently a Professor in the Department of Medical Genetics and Faculty of Medicine, Division of Neurology at the University of British Columbia. Dr. Sadovnick is the geneticist associated with the Multiple Sclerosis (MS) and Alzheimers Clinics, Vancouver Hospital and Health Sciences Center. Her work in these clinics has resulted in the establishment of British Columbia and Canada-wide clinical genetic/genetic epidemiological databases which are relatively unbiased with respect to genetic factors and are representative of the general population of individuals with these disorders. Dr. Sadovnick is currently the principal investigator in the Canadian Collaborative Project on Genetic Susceptibility to MS.
