## Climate Change and Human Health

**Description**

The overall purpose of this 90-minute webinar is to orient participants to the human health issues likely to result from climate change and update participants on federal initiatives in climate change and human health, including the upcoming National Climate Assessment (NCA). The webinar will include leaders within the state and local public health agencies on climate change adaptation, who will spotlight some of their efforts.
