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 <u>Effective Oct. 1, 2020</u>, women who are diagnosed by a non-BCCCP participating provider, and who meet all other NC BCCCP eligibility criteria, may be eligible to apply for BCCM.

Breast and Cervical Cancer Medicaid (BCCM)

Provides funding for treatment to women who are diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer and who meet NC BCCCP eligibility requirements.

Eligibility

- Patients must be referred to the local NC BCCCP to apply for BCCM;
- Women with family incomes at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level, who are uninsured or underinsured, and who are not covered by Medicare Part B.






