Response to Executive Summary

- Develop a strategic plan: present to the September 2010 council
- Develop and implement a plan to stimulate collaborative research among SRP grantee
- Continue to emphasize research translation with increased focus on new mechanisms for translating research specific to remediation.
- Identify and implement new approaches to conduct research translation with our federal partners, EPA and ATSDR.
- Enhance our promotion of effective and sensitive community outreach





Response to Executive Summary, cont.

Regarding the continuous and ongoing review, assessment and evaluation of the SRP, we will:

- Continue to use the NIH peer review process in the competitive funding of grant applications
- Continue to use NIH required annual review of progress
- Brainstorm with the Division of Extramural Research and Training Program Analysis Branch on other evaluation and assessment approaches

Capture/capitalized "big picture" advances:

 Establish expert panels, which assess progress, advise us on metrics, recommend next steps and identify opportunities for research translation.
