- **Key Personnel:** Individuals who contribute to the project development or execution in a substantive, measurable way, whether or not salaries are requested.
  - **Consultants should also be included if they meet the same definition**
  - **Must devote measurable effort to the project. “Zero percent” or “as needed” are not acceptable levels of involvement.**

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

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## Recommendations/Concerns

- Timely and accurate notification if a hazmat incident has occurred
- Community input on evacuation plans
- Need an independent source of air monitoring who will issue results/notifications
- Need to maintain the placarding/labeling system and more training in this area
- Outreach to communities to educate (like the CERT training)
- Need information on household toxic chemicals
- Need more access to quality hazmat training
- Phase out and/or substitute toxic chemicals

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
