Why is PPE Important?

Don't Forget the Hierarchy of Controls

- Eliminate hazard
- Engineering controls
- Administrative controls
- PPE

Four ^(1/2) Levels of PPE

- Level A
- Level B
- Level B+
- Level C
- Level D

Why choose one over another?

Level A

- Supplied air respirator
- Encapsulating suite
- Inner and outer gloves (outer gloves are part of the suite)
- Boots (may be part of the suite)
- May have head protection



Level B and B+

- Supplied air respirator
- Splash suite
- Inner and outer gloves
- Boots
- May have head protection



Level C

- APR (full or 1/2 face) or PAPR
- Splash suite
- Inner and outer gloves
- Eye Protection if 1/2 face APR is worn
- Boots
- May have head protection



Level D

- May be...
 - Apron
 - Gloves
 - Hard hat
 - Eye Protection
 - Boots
 - (Basic work PPE)

What Does Federal Guidance Say?

- APHIS: 9-18-2007 (6800.1)
 - Hand Protection
 - Body Protection
 - Foot Protection
- OSHA-2006 (3323-10N)
 - Eye Protection
 - Respirator

Concerning Respirators...

- Respiratory protection program
- Medical clearance
- Fit testing
- Proper selection
 - Evaluate Chemical Hazard
 - Evaluate O₂
 - If APR is there a cartridge
 - Is there a governing standard

Types of Respirators

- Supplied Air
 - Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA)
 - Air Line
- Powered Air Purifying Respirators (PAPR)
- Air Purifying Respirators (APR)
 - Full Face
 - Half Face

Concerning CPC

- Four point approach to selecting CPC
 - Evaluate hazard
 - Evaluate exposure to hazard
 - Evaluate chemical resistance
 - Evaluate physical resistance

What are the Health and Safety Issues of Wearing PPE?

- Decreased vision, agility, communication, etc.
- Increased heat stress
- Issues of claustrophobia
