



- ✓ **WASH UP!**
During and after a visit to the shoreline area, make certain that everyone in your group washes their hands and face thoroughly before eating and drinking.
- ✓ **STAY ON THE TRAIL!**
Do not trespass into fenced contaminated areas that warn passers-by to keep out.
- ✓ **LEAVE THE MUD BEHIND!**
After a visit to the shoreline, bathe children and pets thoroughly. Remove and wash muddy shoes to prevent spreading possible chemical toxins throughout your home.
- ✓ **IF YOU FISH . . .**
Don't eat more than the recommended amount of fish caught at the shoreline.
