

Another process affecting health is disease damage, which is the effect on your body from previous disease damage and treatments for the myositis. Disease damage lasts at least six months (and sometimes forever) and is difficult (and sometimes impossible) to improve. Some examples of myositis damage include things like muscle scarring or thinning (atrophy) and scarring of previously active skin rashes.
