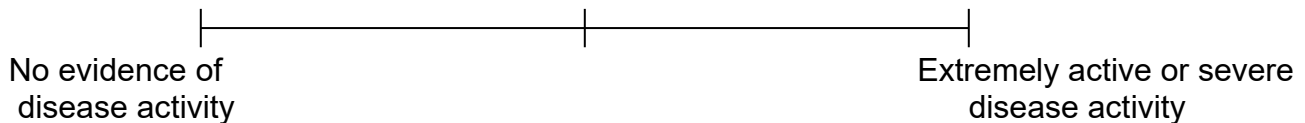

Physician Global Activity Assessment

Disease Activity is defined as potentially reversible pathology or physiology resulting from the myositis. Clinical findings known or suspected to be due to another disease process should not be considered in this evaluation. The global assessment of disease activity is to be judged from all the information available to you today including the subject's appearance, history, physical examination, diagnostic laboratory testing and your resultant medical therapy.

1. Please rate your global (overall) disease activity assessment by drawing a vertical mark on the 10-cm. line below according to the following scale: left end of line = no evidence of disease activity, midpoint of line = moderate disease activity, and right end of line = extremely active or severe disease activity.



2. The Physician Global Disease Activity Assessment may also be completed a 21-point numeric rating scale that ranges from 0-10 and is in 0.5 increments, which measures a patient's overall evaluation of their disease activity. "0" indicates no evidence of disease activity and "10" indicates maximal disease activity.
