- Average Award - \$100,000

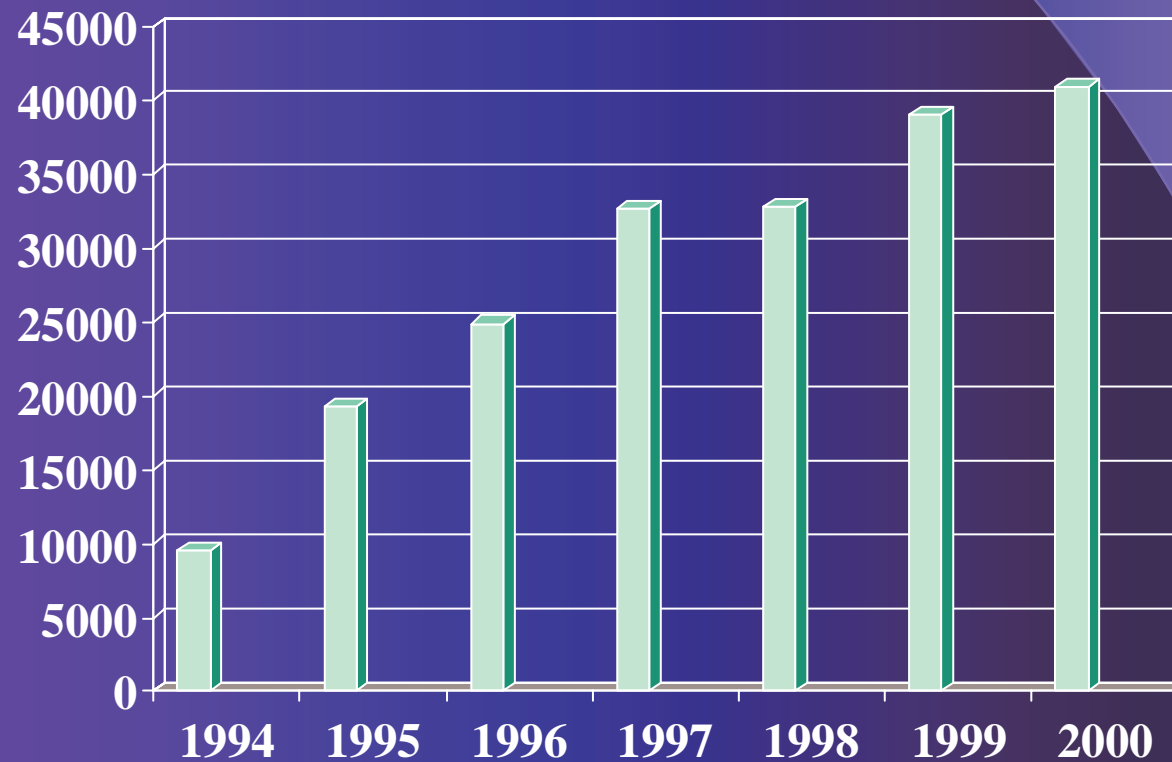
Susan Harwood Training Grant Program

 - Hard-to-Reach Workers
- \$5 Million for new grants

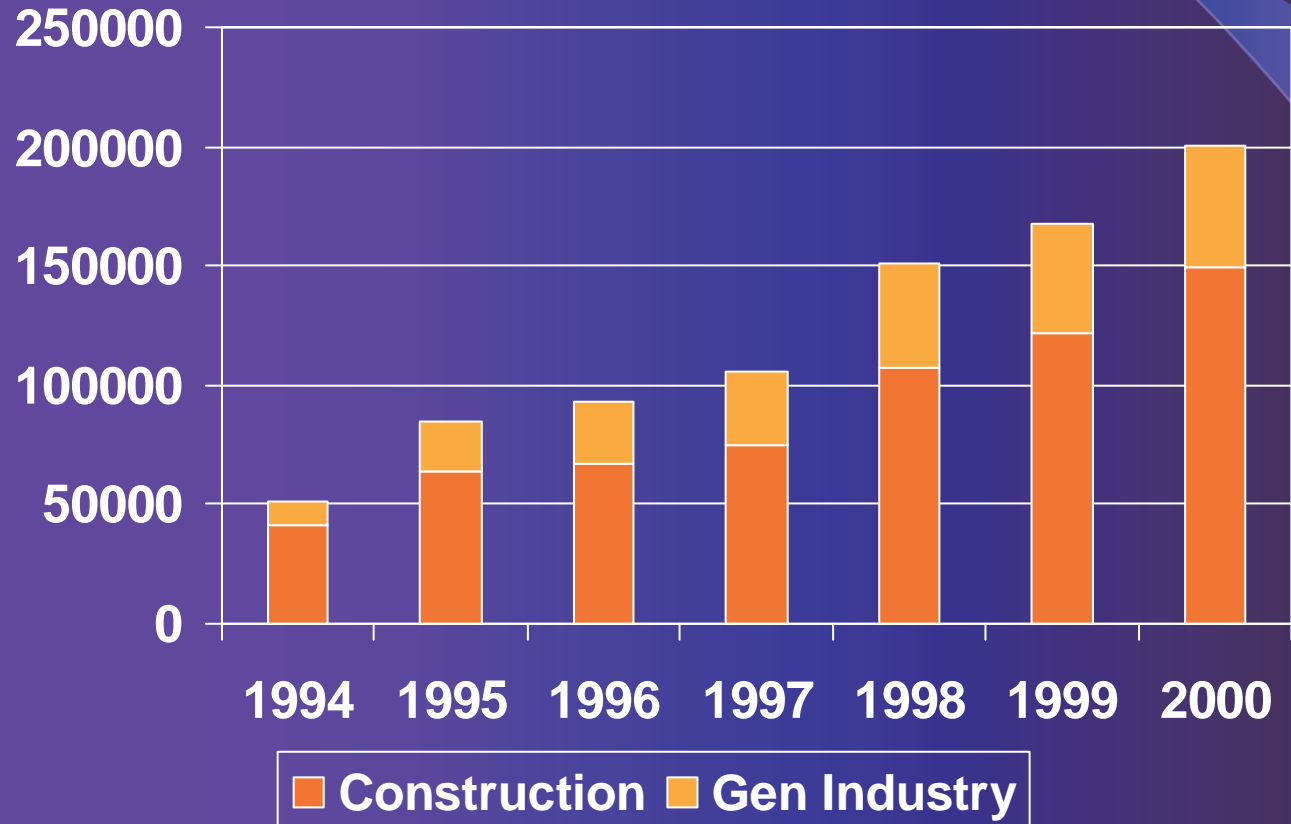
OSHA Training Grants Numbers Trained
