DOE Training



- DOE Recognizes the Importance of Worker Training
 - required in DOE directives
 - Required in DOE Rules
 - Required by Acquisition Rules



Training Policy Examples



- 10 CFR 835, “ Occupational Radiation Protection”
 - Subpart J – Radiation Safety Training
 - “all general employees shall be trained in radiation safety”
- 10 CFR 850, “ Chronic Beryllium Disease Prevention Program”
 - 850.7 Training and counseling



Training Policy Examples



- 10 CFR 851, “Worker Safety and Health Program”
 - 851.25 Training and Information
 - “contractor must provide training for new workers, periodic training, additional training when S&H information changes
 - Specific training required by Appendix A Functional Areas, i.e., Industrial Hygiene, Fire Safety, etc.
 - All training requirements contained in 29 CFR 1910 and 29 CFR 1926



Training Policy Examples



- 49 CFR “DEAR”
“Personnel must possess the experience, knowledge, skills and abilities that are necessary to discharge their responsibilities
- DOE P 450.4 , “Safety Management Systems”
Guiding Principle “ Competence Commensurate with Responsibility” – personnel shall possess the experience, knowledge ...”



Training Policy Examples



- DOE O 440.1B, “Worker Protection Management for DOE and NNSA Federal Employees”
 - Provide workers, supervisors, managers, visitors ... w/ worker protection training.
