



3. Audience Information – Language, Audience, Grade Level.
4. Material Content – Material Type (file or URL), File to Upload (if applicable), Format, File Type, subject matter expert review.



PEPH Resource Center Material Requirements

The PEPH Resource Center Material Requirements were developed to ensure that quality materials are uploaded to the Resource Center without being overly burdensome.

The Material Requirements are divided into four sections:

1. Relevance and Validity
2. Style Requirements
3. Usability
4. Miscellaneous

Benefits of PEPH Resource Center

- Promote networking within and across programs
- Facilitates sharing of approaches and materials
- Advances educational and outreach methods
- Increases distribution of materials
- Provides mechanism to post materials on the NIEHS web pages.

Who can use the PEPH Resource Center?

The PEPH Resource Center is a resource for all individuals who are currently working for, or who have previously worked for, a program that falls under the PEPH umbrella.

To use the PEPH Resource Center you must have a NIHEXT (NIH extranet account).

Types of PEPH Grantee User Accounts

There are two different types of Grantee accounts with different permissions.

- **Grantee Admin account:** This user can upload materials to the Resource Center and edit materials submitted to the Resource Center that are associated with his/her project. Admin User can also browse/search/download all materials published to the Resource Center.
- **Grantee User account:** This user can browse/search/download all materials published to the Resource Center, but cannot upload or edit materials.

Next Steps

The development of the PEPH Resource Center is an on-going process and includes grantees, developers and PEPH staff.

Grantee Actions:

1. Register for a NIHEXT account so you can access the Resource Center.
2. Fill out the PEPH Resource Center user list form which identifies individuals associated with your project who need access to the Resource Center and indicates the level of access (grantee user or admin user) for each user.
3. Verify the information in the Resource Center for your institution, project, PI and Points of Contact.
4. Upload materials to the Resource Center.
5. Send us any suggestions you have for Resource Center improvements or enhancements.
