




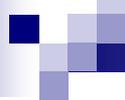
Clearinghouse Projects

- Response to Haiti earthquake – translated earthquake training tool into Haitian Creole
- National Action Summit for Latino Worker Safety and Health
- White paper on Training Workers on the Risks of Nanotechnology
 - Result in a curricula outline




Major Efforts this Year

- Assessment of the NIEHS-funded OSHA 10 and 30 hour and instructor courses
 - Goal is to provide recommendations for quality control measures that OSHA can use
 - Status – We've received responses from most awardees. We've begun an initial analysis.



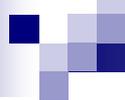
Major Efforts cont.

- Finalizing DOE Safety and Health Training Assessment Report
 - Draft final report was distributed with comments due back last week. Plan to make final changes and distribute by the end of February.
- Continue DOE site visits related to the Safety Training Collaboration Plan
 - Next sites will be Los Alamos and Idaho National Lab



Major Efforts cont.

- Continue agency partnership-building activities and representation work
- Participate in public hearing on HAZCOM standard
- Analysis of program successes beginning with evaluation of MWT/BMWT program
