What is an OpenBadge? An OpenBadge is a digital standard specification for a portable and tangible method to record into metadata skills and achievements in a way that it is displayable and portable over the internet.


Why is it of interest? A badge is like a transcript or diploma which you can collect and display on social media or “backpack” apps on smart phones, desktops or corporate systems. Every entry in a transcript can automatically create a badge for the same event.

- 1) In a browser go to <http://badge.inxsol.com/>
- 2) Select “Sand Box”
- 3) Follow on screen instructions to generate a certificate
- 4) Verify the badge at <https://badgecheck.io/>
