- Trainees report that they plan to use the training tool in conducting their own training programs
- Continuing to conduct TTT and Leadership programs


## COVID-19

- Participation in completing the survey and attending focus groups will be meaningful



## Progress Reports – Example of COVID-19 Reported Evaluation

97% of the participants in the online COVID-19 training agreed or strongly agreed to the statements, “The training has increased my knowledge on how to control COVID-19 workplace exposures on the job” and “The training has prepared me to recognize COVID-19 exposures on the job.”

## COVID-19 Evaluation

1. Grantee Survey: Seven close-ended items on WTP's response to COVID-19
2. Grantee Focus Groups: Discussion on WTP's response to COVID-19
3. Trainee Survey: Online trainees follow-up on challenges faced and resources needed

## Sampling Plan for COVID-19 Evaluation

Grantee Survey	Grantee Focus Groups
<p>WTP staff will notify all PIs and Program directors (as applicable) of an upcoming email that will be sent by WTP contractor.</p> <p>WTP contractor will send one email to all PIs and Program Directors (as applicable) and ask for them to share with consortium leadership (such as subgrantee directors)</p>	<p>Send individual emails to each PI and related Program Directors (as applicable) and ask for them to submit up to 2 names of individuals who would be best to answer the FG questions (which will be attached).</p> <p>They may nominate themselves, a key staff person, a consortium lead, or a trainer.</p> <p>We will plan for a maximum of 6 focus groups with 5-8 participants per group.</p>
