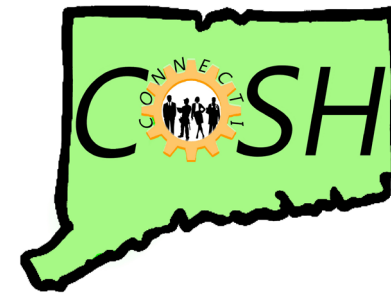


MassCOSH

- Engaging all partners to push city strategies for protection from rising temperatures.



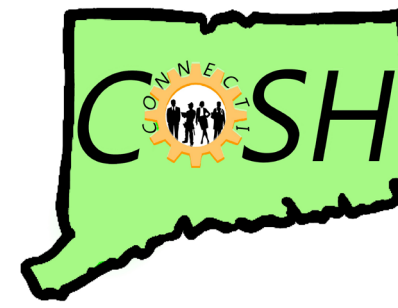
ConnectiCOSH/Naugatuck Valley Recovery Center



- Community-based recovery center to assist low-income residents, people of color in Naugatuck Valley.
- Collaboration with the Naugatuck Valley Project (NVP) – network of 24 congregations, local labor unions, and housing cooperatives.
- CTCOSH expanded H&S training to various vulnerable workers, in Spanish, Portuguese, Haitian Creole.

- 3 Town Halls in Naugatuck Valley. Coordination with CT DPH, H&S issues at local hospital.
- Vaccination education and awareness drive.
- H&S education outreach in tandem with local food delivery.
- Identifying worker leaders in nursing homes → workplace safety, developing leadership skills.
- Educating, empowering workers and community members.
