Boozman College of Public Health announces the search for a tenure-earning faculty position in the Department of Environmental and Occupational Health at the assistant or associate professor level. While all areas of specialization related to Environmental Health will be considered, particular areas of interest are food safety, the role of the microbiome in responses to environmental stressors, or tobacco product risks.

The ideal candidate will use emerging methods for assessing environmental influences of health, including, but not limited to: systems biology, computational biology, bioinformatics, cell-based technologies, or novel regulatory testing methods and risk assessment methods. Collaborative opportunities exist with researchers across the UAMS campus, as well as at the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's National Center for Toxicological Research (FDA NCTR), just south of the UAMS campus. A strong potential for extramural funding is an important qualification, as is a commitment to excellence in teaching and mentoring graduate students.

Candidates should submit an application letter, curriculum vitae, statement of research interest and teaching philosophy, and contact information for three references to [Dr. Gunnar Boysen](#), Search Committee Chair.
