- Identify as: MENA (56%), Black/African American (36%), Asian (11%), White (5%), Hispanic/Latinx (10%)
- 22% born outside U.S.

EHRA fellows completed a **pre-survey** and a **post-survey** to assess:

- Student satisfaction levels,
- Impact on <u>civic engagement</u>
- <u>Gains in knowledge</u> related to environmental health science and data, air pollution health effects and monitoring, and understanding of environmental health literacy
