**This purchase is for:** This contract shall include no less than one (1) preventive maintenance inspection during the contract period. A factory-trained Field Service representative shall perform the service. Service shall consist of, but not limited to, inspection, examination of all functioning parts, thorough cleaning, proper lubrication, replacement or repair of worn or un-serviceable parts, adjustment, and calibration made with the expressed intent of maintaining the instrument to the manufacturer's original specifications. This includes complete dismantling, parts replacement, reassembly, and thorough testing and adjusting when necessary. Additionally, emergency repair service shall be provided on an unlimited basis during the term of this contract at no additional cost to the Government. The contractor shall also furnish all required replacement parts at no extra cost to the Government, except consumable parts. Parts shall be new and meet original equipment specifications. The contractor shall also indicate the ability to provide an unlimited number of demand on-site service visits with a maximum 72-hour response; parts,

labor, and travel at no expense; Priority status for technical support inquiries; One (1) Scheduled Preventative Maintenance visit per performance period; Factory-certified replacement parts included; Software updates and notifications and patches including applicable source code; any subscriptions to support Online Technical Resources.
